

In-Kind Donation Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in supporting our pediatric patients at Cornerstone VNA. Since we care for patients of all ages, from birth through end of life, we have an ongoing need for donations to support our youngest patients through our Kiddie Cornerstone Fund.

The Kiddie Cornerstone Fund was established in 2016 to purchase gifts for pediatric patients receiving home health care or hospice services from Cornerstone VNA. Many of our young patients have chronic illnesses and see our nurses on a regular basis. With your support, our nurses will be able to deliver special gifts, which will help bring smiles to their smallest patients to promote hope and healing at home.

Your generosity and goodwill, through the act of donating, lifts the spirits of our patients and their families. Special toys and activities help to provide play opportunities and make the patient experience less stressful. We have created some general guidelines to help you choose items most appropriate for our patients while they are receiving care from Cornerstone VNA.

In-Kind Guidelines:

- All toys, stuffed animals, and donated items must be new and in their original packaging.
- Paint, glue, crayons, or markers in craft kits must all be labeled non-toxic.
- For patient confidentiality and infection control, donors are not able to deliver gifts directly.
- Items should not be made of glass, have sharp edges, or magnetic pieces, contain small pieces, or be a projectile.
- Gas cards or local restaurant gift cards are appreciated as well for families in need.
